

**Gregg Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Meeting Minutes
February 8, 2024**

The regularly scheduled Board of Supervisors (BOS) meeting for Gregg Township, Centre County, was held on February 8, 2024, at 106 School Street, Suite 203, Spring Mills, PA, with Chair Charles Stover, Ben Haupt, and Vicky Vanada. Others in attendance: Pamela Hackenburg - Secretary/Treasurer, Brandon Ripka – Roadmaster, John Lohta - Solicitor

Chair Stover called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., followed by the pledge of allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Gill Morrison told the Board of Supervisors about the grant deadline for the Sewer Authority. Mr. Haupt explained to him that Roy Rupert and John Corman will take care of the grant. Gill stated they still owe around a million for the sewer loan.

Donna Miller – Tax collector for Gregg Township. Spoke about the meeting that was held by the Board of Commissioners. They decided to go with someone other than RBA to do the tax billing. The tax collectors were never notified and it might cost the Township \$50.00 more a month. Donna will keep us updated.

Zach Gay - SMFG and Kubalak Lot Addition – The Supervisors reviewed the Lot addition. Discussion took place.
