

**Gregg Township Board of Supervisor's
Special Meeting
Tuesday, February 4, 2025 @ 4 pm
Room 203**

Special BOS meeting **called to order** by Chair Ben Haupt at 4 pm.

Present: Ben Haupt and Vicky Vanada

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comments:

1. **Dr. Peter Theodorus** – Dr. Theodorus said that he was sorry to hear about the passing of Charles Stover. Dr. Theodorus said that he has lived in the valley for 30 years and he has never endorsed anyone for public office but he would like to endorse Todd Sweitzer for the BOS vacant seat. Dr. Theodorus said that he has known Todd for over 15 years and he has high integrity and that he has knowledge with estimates, HVAC, and many other areas. Dr. Theodorus said that he hopes that Todd is the next Gregg Twp. Supervisor.
2. **Charles Bierlein** – Charles stated that he is also running for the Township Supervisor vacant seat. Charles then read the letter that he submitted to the township.
3. **Carol Myers** – Carol said that she would like to advocate for Carol Gingrich. Carol Myers said that Carol Gingrich has served on the Advisory Board for at least ten years. Carol Myers said that Carol Gingrich is always looking at saving money and ways to make money for the Advisory Board. Carol Myers said that Carol Gingrich has ways to word things as not to upset anyone and that she is tireless.
4. **Gill Morrison** – Gill said that he is reserving his will to speak later.

New Business:

1. Review and discuss paperwork for BOS applicants. Vote on filling the BOS vacancy position. Chair Haupt said that the vacancy seat is to finish off the last 11 months of the 6-year term. Chair Haupt said that there were three good candidates but what we need at this time is someone that has some knowledge of what is going on in the township and to be able to pick up and keep us moving in the right direction. Chair Haupt said that he feels that Carol Gingrich would be the applicant that Gregg Township needs for right now. Ms. Vanada agreed that there are three good candidates and would encourage them to do the paperwork and submit their names to the Election Office to be on the ballot for the upcoming 6-year term. But, for today, we can only pick one applicant and that this applicant needs to have some knowledge of the current issues the township is facing. Ms. Vanada said that Carol Gingrich has been involved in the township. Motion by Ms. Vanada for Carol Gingrich to fill the 11-month vacant supervisor seat. Second by Mr. Haupt. Vote was unanimous.

Dr. Theodorus said that he would like to see five township supervisors, instead of three. Chair Haupt told him that this was on the ballot previously but it was voted down by the township residents.
2. Increase the IRS mileage from 67 cents to 70 cents. Ms. Vanada explained that when she checked the IRS website in mid-December, that the IRS mileage rate was listed as 67 cents. Then when she checked the website the beginning of January 2025, then it was listed as 70 cents. Motion to approve the IRS mileage rate of 70 cents by Ms. Vanada. Second by Chair Haupt. Vote

was unanimous.

Chair Haupt again announced that we need people to consider running for the upcoming 6-year BOS position.

Motion to adjourn the meeting by Ms. Vanada. Second by Mr. Haupt. Vote was unanimous. Meeting adjourned at 4:16 pm.
